Standards News

- 2A1 Distribute Product Catalog Information
 - R02.00.00 Published – Ready for Validation!
- Payment Milestone Program:
 - This program aspires to design a simple payment process to streamline reconciliation of accounts receivable and improve the payment information flow for faster cash.
 - Objective include reducing processing costs through automating accounts receivable reconciliation and improving the flow of payment information.
- Materials Composition Milestone Program
 - Objective: In response to government regulations and emerging customer expectations, the high-technology supply chain can streamline the exchange of material composition and related information through a standardized and automated global process.

RosettaNet Technical Dictionary (RNTD) Version 3.0

- Vote to approve or disapprove ended February 12
- What's changed?
 - RNTD v3.0 consists of new classes, characteristic sets and characteristics in the Electronic Components (EC) segment
 - Characteristic sets and characteristic modification work in the Information Technology (IT) segment
 - Initial population of classes in the Semiconductor Manufacturing (SM) segment
 - These updates not only extend coverage of the RNTD to all of the supply chains that RosettaNet serves, but also represent a significant enhancement with regard to quality and capabilities.
- RNTD v3.0 also includes the permission statements required for RosettaNet to use, under royalty-free license, including intellectual property from both IEC (International Electrotechnical Commission) and ECALS (ECALS Dictionary from JEITA/IPA).

To: RosettaNet Solution Providers

In spite of today's challenging economy, high technology supply chain companies continue to expand their RosettaNet trading networks, demonstrating the industry's overall commitment to implement business processes that facilitate operational efficiencies and enhance customer satisfaction.

RosettaNet members have prioritized and invested in the development of tools and management processes that measure RosettaNet standards compliance for software products and services. This initiative, referred to as the RosettaNet Ready™ Program, is a subscription-based service that provides a repository of testing tools, compliance testing methodology and RosettaNet Ready badges to identify products that have successfully completed compliance testing.

Proven adherence to RosettaNet standards, through RosettaNet Ready, allows users to differentiate vendor solutions by the usage of consistent criteria. RosettaNet-compliant software products are critical to the ongoing effort of reducing implementation time and cost, enabling wider adoption of RosettaNet standards by small- and mid-tier trading partners and expanding RosettaNet-enabled trading networks worldwide.

To further the momentum and progress we have determined, as RosettaNet Board members representing the industry at large, that we must promote deployment of RosettaNet-compliant solutions and move trading partners toward interoperable solutions.

Accordingly, we resolve that the evaluation of future software, tools and services related to RosettaNet supply chain management initiatives, will include achievement of RosettaNet Ready compliance. All other relevant considerations being equal, we believe that solution providers that have been awarded the RosettaNet Ready badge should have a distinct advantage in promoting their given solution for trading partner connections and community.

We encourage your company to participate in this Program, and your commitment to achieve compliance by successfully earning RosettaNet Ready Compliance Badges.
