- Translation software revelation: Interbridge



Milestones

- 1990 – EDIFICE is domiciled in Geneva, rue du Rhone, 100
- 1991 – EDIFICE 400 service – UN/EDIFACT 90.1 guidelines
- 1996
 - MDG is split into Business Area Task Groups
 - www.edifice.org is introduced
- 1997
 - Plenary meetings are now hosted by member companies : IBM and Meadowhouse host the first one in Madrid in April '97
 - Recast of all MIGs from UN/EDIFACT 92.1 to D97.A
- 1999
 - EDIFICE Repository available on the web (HTML + downloads)
- 2001
 - Introduction of the European RosettaNet User Group ERUG
- 2003
 - EDIFICE profilation as The European B2B forum for the Electronics Industry
 - THE European RosettaNet User Group – Publication of EPIGs
- 2004
 - Collaborative web site is introduced
 - Repository is opened to the public
 - New logo/house style
- 2005
 - Deployment Matrix is introduced

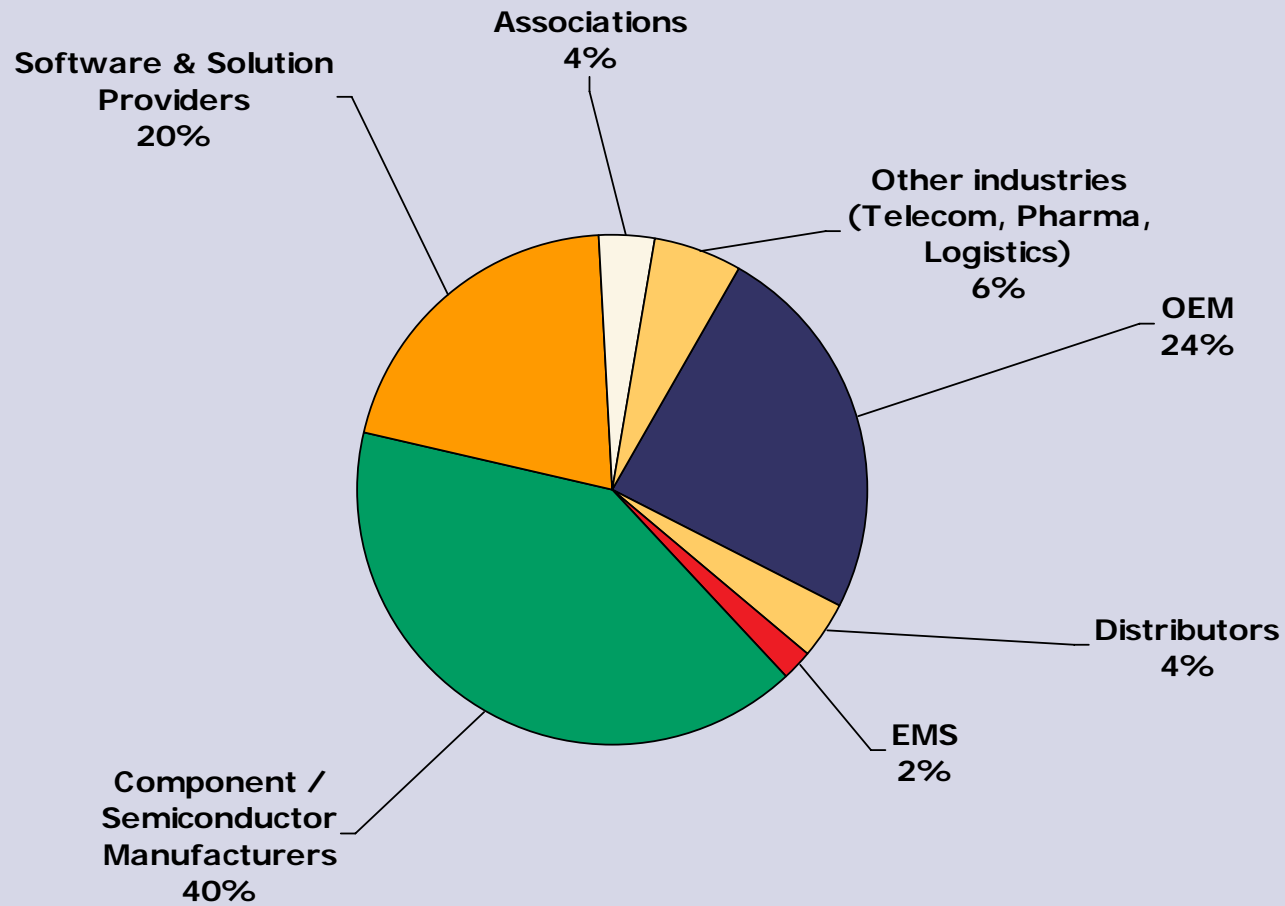
